PROSTART WITH A PURPOSE SCHOLARSHIP



Five non-renewable \$10,000 scholarships will be awarded to current or past ProStart participants who will graduate high school in 2012. The scholarships are valid at any of over 35 locations of The International Culinary Schools at The Art Institutes.

HOW TO ENTER

Applicants must submit the following information. Complete package should be mailed to: The Art Institutes, c/o Terri DeRubeis, 210 Sixth Ave., 33rd Floor, Pittsburgh, PA 15222.

- A completed entry form indicating the school and program of study desired.
- A short essay (maximum of 500 words) legibly handwritten or typed in English that addresses why you'd like to study Culinary Arts or Hospitality Management at one of The International Culinary Schools at The Art Institutes.
- Students must have proof of participation in ProStart. A copy of a partial transcript with ProStart listed as a class will suffice as would a ProStart Certificate of Achievement.
- A letter of recommendation from a ProStart teacher, mentor, chef, or coach is also required.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS & CRITERIA

The scholarship recipient must begin his or her program of study in the summer or fall quarter following high school graduation. The recipient must not interrupt his or her studies; interruption of studies will result in loss of the scholarship. The scholarship will be suspended in quarters when the recipient's cumulative grade point average falls below 2.5.

- All entry materials become the property of The Art Institutes.
- Staff from The International Culinary Schools at The Art Institutes will judge entries based on how well they demonstrate the individual's passion, commitment, and dedication to studying Culinary Arts or Hospitality Management.
- The judging team is not responsible for loss, damage, or return of entry materials.
- The scholarship will be awarded only to a student who has been admitted to his or her chosen Art Institutes school.
- In the event that the scholarship recipient's education is terminated either by the student or the school, the scholarship becomes null and void.
- The tuition scholarship is awarded in the form of a tuition credit and prorated over the length of the student's degree program.
- The scholarship may not be applied against fees, housing, living expenses, or program supplies, and may not be transferred between affiliate schools.
